Our new MLaw four year Integrated Master's programme gives you the opportunity to complete your LLB Law (QLD) and progress to a Master's qualification with SQE preparation which leads to the Solicitors Qualifying Exam. One of very few courses of its kind our MLaw is the perfect balance between globally recognised teaching and research to prepare you for your career as a solicitor.

Delivered in partnership with the University of Law, our MLaw programme combines the University of Reading's LLB Law with the University of Law's professional SQE1 and SQE2 preparation provision, preparing you to sit the Solicitors Qualifying Examinations (SQE).
